April 7, 1976.

The regular meeting of council was held on April 7, 1976 in the Council Chambers with all members.

The minutes of the March meetings were read and adopted by council. The bills were presented.

Concerned ratepayers were present to discuss a possible foot pad being started in the Township.

It was moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that the Township of Ross support the resolution passed by the Township of Admaston and sent to the Honorable Minister of Health to retain the present Health facilities at the Renfrew Victoria Hospital.

Moved by Barrie Ross seconded by Jack Bell that council authorize the Ontario Hydro to install 4 - 250 watt street lights, three at Haley and one in Forester's Falls subject to the approval of M.T.C.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Jack Bell that council set the water rates for Goldwood's Development Sub-Division for the year 1976 at \$9.00 per month.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that council give a grant of \$50.00 to the Cobden Agricultural Society for the purpose of assisting with their Annual Fair.

Moved by Jack Bell seconded by Barrie Ross that council give Mr. Hyatt permission to open up fifty-five more lots for travel trailers. Located on lots 12 & 13 Cor. 2 Ross Township.

Moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Alvin Stone that council pay road voucher No. 3 in the amount of \$9053.55 for the month of March 1976.

Moved by Jack Bell seconded Barrie Ross that accept the estimate on the Forester's Falls sidewalks submitted by Henry Tabbat for \$5350.60.

John Bell was appointed to approach Lloyd Skate to look after sweeping the streets in Forester's Falls.

Mr. Gerald Goley, Planner for the County, is to be notified that the Township is interested in planning and zoning.

April 20, 1976

A special meeting of council was held on April 20th, 1976.

Plans for another subdivision were presented to council but they advised to wait until the county Planner had been consulted.

A complaint was heard from a ratepayer about the bus at the end of the 5th Line Municipal Drain. He was advised that the engineers would be consulted and he would be notified of their decision.

It was moved by John Bell seconded by Barrie Ross that council pass a by-law accepting the estimate of P. H. Duffy Road Oiling Limited to supply, haul and apply 1607 tons of 3/8 stone, 48,781 gal. of oil for 9.8 miles of single surface treatment. Total price \$42,332.53.

And supply, haul and apply double surface treatment for 7/10 mile of 8,400 gal. of oil and 315 tons of 3/8 stone at a price of \$7,668.15.

Total price of estimate \$50,000.68

Subject to the approval of Ministry of Transportation and Communications,

Council approved one acre lots for the Huckabone subdivision.
