The regular meeting of the Ross Municipal Council was held on June 2, 1976 with all members present.

The minutes of the May meetings were read and adopted by council. The bills were presented.

It was moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that the council of the Township of Ross pay road vouchers No. 5 in the amount of \$8,761.15 for the month of May 1976.

It was moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that council delegate the Clerk-Treasurer to attend the Seminar on Municipal Elections to be held in the Renfrew County Administration Building on Sept 23rd and 24th, 1976, with the Township of Ross to pay the registration fee of \$20.00.

After a letter was read from Mr. Albert Edmunds requesting that a road be closed, it was decided not to close it as it may be used in the future.

Council endorsed the resolution from the Township of Amaranth requesting that the Ministry of Agricultural & Food remove the restriction of money available for tile drain loans and the 2% increase in interest.

Council gave consent to RCAF Association Strig #433 to display the fire truck and also gave consent the organization to purchase a liquor lic.

It was suggested that the Town approach the Library Board to abide by the Public Library Act at the beginning of the year.

The regular meeting of the Ross Municipal Council was held on July 7, 1976 in the council chamber with all members present.

The minutes of the June meetings were read and adopted by council. The bills were presented.

A delegation of ratepayers were present to discuss the raise in the 1976 dog tax. Council explained ^{Ontario} legislation to the ratepayers -

Also a request to have a road officially closed at Lot 8, Cor. 8 onto County Road #7 was heard and discussed. It was decided to discuss this with our Solicitor.

It was the discussion of council to accept one-half payment of a dog tax but to inform the ratepayers that only one-half is paid.

Council decided to sell the hay at the Waste Disposal Site to Claude Oates for 40¢ a bale.

Jack Bell was appointed to have the Library Roof repaired. Moved by John Bell seconded by Bernie Ross that Council give \$2000.00 to Cobden Union Cemetery Board as a contribution towards building the Cobden and District Vault.
