

Forester's Falls, Ontario

September 9, 1976

A special meeting of council was held on September 15th, 1976 to discuss tile drainage loans.

Moved by Jack Bell seconded by Barrie Ross that council accept the following applications for tile drain loans. Donald Hard and Carol F. Dowdall, Lot 9, Con. 7, Total cost of drain \$4,000, Loan \$3,000, Date completed Nov. 1, 1976 and Keith Bennett, Lots 3+4, Con. 5 and Lot 9, Con. 6. Total cost of drains \$11,500, Loan \$8,600, Date completed October 15, 1976. Total amount of loans \$11,600.

The 'catch basins' in the Municipal Drains were discussed and it was decided that Allan Cole would be asked to check the Haly Municipal Drain, if necessary James Chud would be asked to clean them out. John Bell offered to look after the Forester's Falls Drains.

Council requested that Alton Haver be contacted about cleaning the furnaces.

Homer Hamilton was given authority to have the lawn mower overhauled.

Alvin Stone reported that the Athletes' Association were interested in a L.P. Grant and they were applying themselves.

Sept 9

The pit for the winter at the Waste Disposal Site was discussed.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that the Council of the Township of Ross set the following standards whereby Welfare applicants will be received.

- 1. To persons for Health reasons or medically unfit to work.
- 2. There will be no welfare payments for applicants who are not registered with Canada Manpower Centre or if they refuse work offered to him from any source.

A letter was received from the Ministry of Agriculture and Food requesting support for a warble fly program. Council are interested but would like more information.

The meeting was adjourned.
