October 6, 1976

The regular meeting of the Ross Municipal Council was held in the Council Chamber on October 6, 1976 with all members present.

The minutes of the September meetings were read and adopted by council and the bills were presented.

A delegation was present requesting that council open a road to the Ottawa River allowing residents to launch a boat. Council agreed to look into the matter.

Opening a road allowance along the Ross-Horton Townline was discussed and council agreed to it being opened if Horton would see that expenses were paid.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that the Council of the Township of Ross pay road vouchers No. 9 in the amount of \$13,833.64 for the month of September 1976.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that Council would contribute the sum of \$200.00 to the Renfrew County Cattleman's Association to help defray the costs of warble fly control in the Township of Ross, with each application from Ross Township to receive 25% of their cost of material until this sum of \$200.00 is used up.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that Council authorize the Clerk-Treasurer to attend the gone meeting for all Kelpin Administrators on Wed. Oct. 27, 1976 at the Lonsdale Lodge Home for the aged in Perth with the registration fees and transportation cost to be paid by the Township.

John Bell offered to look after Renton for the fire hydrants at the townsite.

Moved by John Bell seconded by Barrie Ross that the attached list of uncollectable taxes in the amount of \$320.20 be written off the tax roll as provided by section 636 subsection 1 and section 636A subsection 1 of the Municipal Act.

Moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Alvin Stone that Council pass a by-law for the purpose of refunding taxes in the amount of \$5.77 as recommended by the Clerk-Treasurer as provided by section 636A subsection 1 of the Municipal Act.

Moved by Alvin Stone and seconded by Ray Bennett that the Council pass a resolution requesting the County of Lennox to act on their behalf to encourage the Department of Transportation and Communications to continue to maintain that part of old Highway #17 and #653 after the completion of the new Highway #417 whereas, the old highway would be used as a provincial connection of other Provincial Highways #60 south to Douglas and also #132 in Lennox and back to #417 east below Lennox.
