Nov. 3, 1976

This regular meeting of Ross Municipal Council was held on November 3, 1976 in the Council Chambers with all members present.

The minutes of the October meeting was read and adopted by Council. The bills were presented.

Council agreed to draw fill so that Cameron Brown could get his machinery to his property.

Moved by Alvin Stone and seconded by Ray Bennett that the Council pass a resolution requesting the County of Lennox to act on their behalf to encourage the Department of Transportation and Communications to continue to maintain that part of old Highway #17 and #653 after the completion of the new Highway #417 whereas, the old highway would be used as a provincial connection of other Provincial Highways #60 south to Douglas and also #132 in Lennox and back to #417 east below Lennox.

Nov. 3, 1976.

Moved by Jack Bell and seconded by Barrie Ross that Council pass a resolution accepting the service road from Highway 653 to the Iowa line between Ross and Horton with the understanding that The Ministry of Transportation and Communications repair all major washouts in the spring of 1977 on this road.

It was moved by Ray Bennett and seconded by Alvin Stone that Council pay road voucher # 10 in the amount of \$5,053.30 for the month of October 1976.

Moved by Barrie Ross and seconded by Jack Bell that Council give a donation of ten dollars to the Royal Canadian Legion Golden Branch towards the purchase of a wreath for Remembrance Day.

It was moved by Alvin Stone and seconded by Ray Bennett that consent be given James Huckabone to construct a Service Garage on his property, subject to the standards set down in the Ontario Building Code and adopted by the Township of Ross.

Moved by Jack Bell and seconded by Barrie Ross that Council permit Offam - Canada to sell raffle tickets within the Township of Ross providing they agree to our By Law.

Bell Byee notified Council that he will not be able to snowplough the streets in Forest's Dale this winter.

A request to have two additional culverts put into the new road past Albert Edmunds was refused by Council as the Township has not taken over this road and his request must go directly to Ministry of Transportation and Communications. However, the road was measured only 50ft wide with no shoulders and Council are requesting that this be widened.

1. That these municipalities have nothing in common.
2. That no better grants could be promised.
3. That if amalgamation were possible it should be by
 mutual agreement.
4. That administration costs would save out of pigsties.

Moved by John Bell seconded by Barrie Ross that Council
 pass a Resolution requesting the Ministry of Transportation and
 Communications for the final subsidy payment of \$ for the
 year 1976.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that the
 Council grant permission for use of the dead stock disposal Area
 in the Township Dump to Local Business man, Pat Roscoe, he being
 the prime user of this area, be assessed the sum of \$50.00.

Starting date for Dead Stock disposal area shed Dec 1/76.

Closing date for Dead Stock disposal area shed April 16, 1977.

Moved by John Bell seconded by Barrie Ross that Council
 pay Henry Tabbert twenty-six hundred and seventy-five dollars
 and thirty cents for half the footage on the sidewalks. The remainder
 to be completed early in the summer of 1977 at the same price as
 the contract called for.
