Moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Alvin Stone that the council of the Township of Renfrew enact the following schedule of wages retroactive to Jan 1/77.

Casual Labour - \$4.00 per hr.

Labour - \$4.78 " "

Tractor Truck & Grader grader \$5.29 " "

Grader Operator \$5.39 from April 1st to Oct 31st.

Assistant Road foreman 10% per hr extra when required.

That all new employees work for a period of six months at the labour rate of \$4.78 per hr or at the discretion of the road supervisor he becomes a permanent employee. At which time he will be eligible for the respective hourly rate for his designated position.

Moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Alvin Stoe that council pay road voucher No. 1 in the amount of \$10,811.88 for the month of January, 1977.

Moved by Alvin Stoe seconded by Ray Bennett that the council of the Township of Ross accept the intent and content of the resolution passed by the Municipality of Caronport Thurs. Jan 13, 1977 being a resolution concerning the inability of farmers to pass on increased production costs to the market place. That letters of our indication to endorsement of this resolution be sent to the Hon. Howard Newman and the Hon. Eugene A. Belons.

Moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Alvin Stoe that council give Forester's Falls Athletic Association a grant of \$300.00 to overcome expenses for the year 1977.

Ministry of Transportation and Communications advised council
