April 6, 1977

The regular monthly meeting of Ross Municipal Council was held on April 6, 1977 with all members present.

The minutes of the March meetings were read and adopted by council. The bills were presented.

Moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Alvin Stone that council pay road vouchers #3 in the amount of \$8,801.64 for the month of March 1977.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that council annul By-Law #1064 and enforce By-Law #1052 being a by-law to regulate the keeping of dog kennels within the municipality of the Township of Ross.

Moved by John Bell seconded by Barrie Less that council amend By-Law #945, 3, 3.11.3 to quote a travel trailer or tourist camp \$50.00 for each year.

Corrections were made on the township map to be used on the Planimeter to be erected in the Cobden Park. Council also decided to use "Old English" lettering.

A letter from the Central Mortgage + Housing Corporation was discussed and it was decided to meet with a representative at a later date.

An "application for a tourist rotarf" was completed and sent to the Ministry of Fisheries + Environment for their consideration. After due course a representative will meet with council for further information.

James Skatt, Renfrew County and District, Health Unit informed council that a water survey in the hamlet of Foresters Falls would be started not later than the first of May.

Moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Alvin Stone that council grant the North Renfrew Agricultural Society \$75.00 towards the 1977 fall fair.

Moved by John Bell seconded by Barrie Ross that council call tenders for crushing gravel for the roads. Tenders will be received by the undersigned not later than 12:00 noon, May 4, 1977 for approximately 18,000 tons of $\frac{3}{8}$ material.

Tenders may be obtained from the Road Superintendent or at the Municipal Office.

Moved by Barrie Ross seconded by John Bell that council call tenders for fence material for the year 1977 as follows:

500 rods - 8 strand 42" fence wire

500 - 7' steel posts

400 - 8' cedar posts

gates, staples and brace wire

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that council grant the Building Inspector the authority to issue Building Permits (under Ontario Law) to contractors who are registered with HUDAC
