The regular meeting of the Ross Municipal Council was held on July 6, 1977 in the council chambers.

The minutes of the June meetings were read and adopted by council. The bills were presented.

Moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Alvin Stone that a \$50.00 deposit per key per business be made to the clerk for the remainder of 1977 and \$50.00 for each calendar year thereafter. The following conditions must be complied with:

This agreement will terminate and key must be returned if business changes owners.

Moved by John Bell seconded by Barrie Ross that By-Law # 25-77 be a By-Law to restrict the use of land on the Huckabone Subdivision

Moved by John Bell seconded by Barrie Ross that By-Law # 24-77 be a By-Law to authorize the execution of an agreement with the Ministry of Transportation and Communications for Ottawa relating to a road under the jurisdiction of the Corporation of the Township of Ross

Designated as development road number 1285.

Being that road from County Road No. 7 northerly to County Road No. 21 between Concession IV & V Township of Ross approximately 5.5 miles.

Moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Alvin Stone that council pay road vouchers no. 6 in the amount of \$45,245.64 for the month of June 1977.

A decal was received from the Ottawa Good Roads Association in recognition that Felix Lathwell had successfully completed another three day course in the "C.S. Anderson" Road School.

Keith Bennett was offered any day that he wanted off the Waste Disposal Site for the use of his water truck used at fires.

It was suggested that some kind of warning be erected at the Ottawa River warning motorists of the sharp turn.
