The regular meeting of the Ross Municipal Council was held on Aug. 3rd, 1977 in the council chamber with all members present.

The minutes of the July meetings were read and adopted by council. The bills were presented.

A ratepayer was informed that only when a road is rebuilt does the Township build a new fence.

The road superintendent was instructed to erect a "yield" sign at the corner of George Alnstead's road and the New Line.

Moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Alvin Stone that council pay road voucher No. 7 in the amount of \$7,466.08 for the month of July, 1977.

It was moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Alvin Stone that the council of the Township of Ross give permission to Ross Township Haley Community Centre to hold a street dance, and block off Haley Main Street from Lot 1 to Lot 6 inclusive on R.P. 87, on August 20th, 1977. All obstructions and debris to be removed from Township Road and surrounding property immediately following dance.

A special meeting of council was held on August 18, 1977 to further discuss the Hucklebore sub-division.

The Street Lighting is to be done by the Township at the owners expense. Council agreed to name the forced road "Hill Road" and the street through the sub-division "Meadow Lane." Street is to be built to MTC standards under the supervision of a Township Inspector. Township will accept the street upon completion with a one (1) year ^{from Mt Hucklebore} guarantee against workmanship and material. A drain to re-route a natural water run was discussed and it was the decision of council to refuse responsibility of future maintenance on the drain.

Council decided to post "No Trespassing" signs at the Waste Disposal Site in an attempt to cut down vandalism.

Mr. Bryan, MTC, informed council by telephone that MTC are prepared to remove five (5) vertical grades on the 4th Line Delegation Rd and that work would begin shortly.

Moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Alvin Stone that the council of the Township of Ross give permission to Ross Township Holy Community Centre to hold a street dance and block off Holy Main Street from lots 1 to 6 inclusive on RP 84, on Aug 24, 1977. All obstructions and debris to be removed from Township Road and surrounding property immediately following dance.
