A special meeting of council was held on September 13, 1977 to discuss the grant structure for the Ministry of Culture & Recreation.

Bob Lucas and Ed. Belfry were present from the ministry explaining the basic grant system. Mr. Belfry pointed out that

1. Could take or amend part to the existing by-law.
2. One application of intent for each project, separating the dollars for

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each project.

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3. Send both copies at the same time.

4. Application must be in before project started.

A committee of 5-12 persons must be appointed by council but directors from different parts of the Township may be active and report to Township Committee. Council would require a budget from such a committee.

The Clerk was instructed to inform H. Alcock Jackson that a foundation is required under a mobile unit in the Township of Ross.
