Moved by John Bell seconded by Alvin Stone that the Council of the Township of Ross accept Donalme Motor Ltd. truck tender for a 1978 Ford L 900 truck, 2 way spreader & dump body, front wing post and cross member hydraulic wing tower, front mounted pump 534 cu. in. engine with a 2300 lb. rear axle at a cost of \$33,919.00 including sales tax as per tender price. Subject to the approval of Ministry of Transportation & Communications -

Moved by John Bell seconded by Barry Ross that council increase the road employee's wages 6% as follows:

Casual Labour \$4.24

Labour \$5.06

Tractor, truck & grad operator 5.60

Grad operator \$5.70 from April 3, to October 31, 1978

Or if Anti-Inflation Board will approve a 4.3% increase for tractor, truck & grad operator effective January 1, 1978.
