A special meeting of council was held on March 7th, 1978 to discuss the 1978 budget.

After some discussion the budget was tentatively approved and the clerk was advised to consult Mr. Kimura, Ministry of Treasury, Economics & Intergovernmental Affairs advisor for final approval.

Moved by Barrie Ross seconded by John Bell that council set the 1978 water rates as follows:

\$10.00 per month for each occupied lot

\$250 per month for each unoccupied lot

Billings to be three times a year with a penalty clause of 1% after due date.

Water will be cut off after 30 days default.

A name sign on the Township Garage was discussed.

The meeting was adjourned.

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April 5, 1978

The regular monthly meeting of the Ross Municipal Council was held on April 5th, 1978 in the Council Chambers with all members present.

Moved by Barry Ross seconded by Ray Bennett that the minutes of the March session be adopted as circulated.

The bills were presented.

Don Dondall, representative from Green, Holloway & Associates was present to explain their plan for the 4th Line Development Road. Council agreed to have Green, Holloway & Associates submit the plan as explained, including replacing the culverts.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that the council of the Township of Ross submit the sum of \$100,000 to the Renfrew County Mutual Aid Fire Service for the purpose of establishing a Foam Bank in Renfrew County. This AFFF foam will be used on oil or gasoline fires and would be available to all departments in the County on replacement basis.

Moved by John Bell seconded by Barrie Ross that Council accept the Anti-Inflation approval of 1978 road

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employees wages as follows:

Casual Labour \$4.33 per hr

Labour \$5.17 per hr

Tractor, trucks,

Grader Operator \$5.72 per hr

Grader Operator \$5.82 from April 3 to Oct. 31, 1978

Road Superintendent \$14,092.34 per year.

✓ Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that Council call tenders for crushing gravel for roads.

Tenders will be received not later than 12: noon May 2nd, 1978 of approximately 12,000 Ton.

Tenders may be obtained from the Road Superintendent or the Township Clerk.

✓ Moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Alvin Stone that Council pay road voucher No. 3 in the amount of \$8,423.23 for the month of March 1978.

✓ Moved by John Bell seconded by Barrie Ross that the Council of the Township of Ross approve the following mill rates for the year 1978.

Also that Council approve the dates for payment of taxes and the rate of interest for 1978 as follows:

First Instalment due June 30th, 1978

Second Instalment due October 31st, 1978

There shall be 3% discount on the second instalment paid or on before June 30th, 1978.

Taxes shall be payable at the Ross Municipal Office or for a 25% charge at the Bank of Nova Scotia, Cobden.

✓ Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that the Council of the Township of Ross gives a Grant of \$100⁰⁰ to the Cobden Agricultural Society for the purpose of supporting the 1978 Fair.

✓ Moved by John Bell seconded Barrie Ross that Council give a Grant of \$75⁰⁰ to North Kenton Agricultural Society for their Fall Fair in 1978.

✓ A letter was received from a ratepayer stating he had no

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objection to a boat launch at the Ottawa River on Lot 37 but does object to it on Lot 38.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that the Council of the Township of Ross submit the sum of \$440.97 to the Kennew County Agricultural Veterinary Unit for the purpose of supporting the existing Veterinary Subsidy programme for Kennew County.

A letter was received from Mr. A. A. McZak advising council that Schedule "F" to the Hockabone Subdivision Agreement includes "rip-rap at the end of the drain to be made up of rock and cement."
