January 9, 1979.

A special meeting of council was held on January 9th, 1979 to discuss the wages for 1979.

Moved by Jack Ferguson seconded by John Bell that Council increase the local employee's wages as follows:

Casual Labour \$3.33

Labour 6.17

Master Truck & goods quarter 6.32

Grades Operator 10¢ from April 1st to Oct. 30th 1979.

Road Superintendent \$5,572.00 plus 20¢ per mile.

Assistant Road Foreman 10¢ per hr. extra when required.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that the Council of the Township of Ross authorize a by-law to regulate the re-embursement to Volunteer Firemen within the Township of Ross. That these reimbursements (re-rates) for Volunteer Firemen be as follows:

Fire-Chief \$500.00 per year

Deputy Fire Chief \$400.00 per year

Fireman - \$70.00 per hour while on Fire Duty - authorized by Fire Chief or Deputy Fire Chief.

Week-end Duty - \$25.00 per day, week-ends authorized by Fire Chief and Deputy Fire Chief.

Moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Alvin Stone that Council of the Twp. of Ross request the Workmen's Compensation Board to increase compensation benefits for Volunteer Firemen from \$6240 per year to the sum of \$10,000.00 per year.

Moved by John Bell seconded by Jack Ferguson that the Council of the Township of Ross adjust the salary of Mrs. H. Hood, Clerk, Treasurer and Tax Collector, to \$9,500.00 plus \$917.00 travelling expenses.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that the Council of the Township of Ross adjust the salary of Mrs. Margie Cole, Deputy Clerk & Deputy Tax Collector, at the rate of \$3,750 per hour for the year 1979.

Moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Alvin Stone that the Council of the Township of Ross pass a by-law for the purpose of paying the caretaker Mrs. Beulah Collins, of the Municipal Office and grounds at the rate of \$105.00 per month.

Moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Alvin Stone that the Council of the Township of Ross pass a by-law for the purpose of paying Mrs. Dorothy M. Laughlin, Librarian, at the rate of \$3.00 per hour.

Moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Alvin Stone that the Council

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of the Township of Ross adjust the salary of Homer Hamilton, Waterworks Utility Foreman, to the rate of \$6.20 per hour plus \$50.00 stand-by.

Moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Alvin Stone that the council of the Township of Ross appoint Edsel Johnson as By-Law Enforcement Officer for the following: By-Law # 905, 942, 960, 994, 1070, 1056, 1057, 1069, 36-75 and that he be appointed Township Clerk for the year 1979 at the rate of \$6.36 per hr. plus 20¢ per mile for travelling on business.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that the council of the Township of Ross pay 20¢ per mile for Township Employees & Officials on Council business.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that the council of the Township of Ross give the L.O.R. # 552 a grant of \$75.00 for the use of their Hall for 1978.

Moved by John Bell seconded by Jack Ferguson that the council of the Township of Ross appoint Alvin Stone as Representative on the Renfrew County Agricultural Veterinary Unit.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that Council pass a resolution that any lands in Ross Township on the 1979 tax sale, which are unsold in the adjoining tax sale shall be purchased by the Municipality of the Township of Ross and the requirements of Sec. 568 (3) of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1970 be met.
