The regular monthly meeting of the Ross Municipal Council was held on April 4th, 1979 in the council chambers with all members present.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that the minutes be adopted as circulated.

Correspondence included information that the Ministry of Housing are starting a survey to determine the need for senior citizens housing throughout the Township.

Moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Alvin Stone that council pay road vouchers # 3 in the amount of \$7,519.00 for the month of March 1979.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that the council of the Township of Ross approve the following rates for Councillors, Deputy Reeve & Municipal Reeve.

- Councillor - \$35.00 per meeting
- Deputy Reeve - \$35.00 per meeting plus \$200.00 per year
- Reeve - Rate per year, twice that of Highest Councillor
- Expenses fee per member \$250.00 per year.

Plus 20¢ per mile for Municipal purposes outside the municipality.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that the council of the Township of Ross authorize the Clerk-Treasurer to apply for an

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Ontario Home Renewal Program Grant in the amount of \$35,000.00. Also that Edsel Johnson be appointed Property Standards Officer.

Moved by Jack Ferguson seconded by Ray Bennett that the council of the Township of Ross, appoint a Building Inspector, pursuant to the Building Code Act 1974. Edsel Johnson is hereby appointed the Building Inspector, for the Township of Ross, under the Building Code Act as amended and for all purposes in regard to the administration of the said Act.

A special meeting of council was held on April 17, 1979 to discuss new legislation regarding recreational grants.

Rick Baker, representative from the Ministry of Culture & Recreation was present to explain the grants available through new legislation for recreational purposes.
