April 17, 1979

A special meeting of council was held on April 17, 1979 to discuss new legislation regarding recreational grants.

Rick Baker, representative from the Ministry of Culture & Recreation was present to explain the grants available through new legislation for recreational purposes. Local athletic groups were represented to discuss the new structure compulsory to be eligible for grants. A by-law is necessary to appoint 5-12 persons on a Township board. It was left for the groups to discuss and report back.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that a by-law to revoke the exemption from taxes for religious institutions granted under by-law number 947 be revoked.

Moved by John Bell seconded by Jack Ferguson that Council support the letter from the Corporation of Village of Clark River dated April 12, 1979 to the Renfrew County School Board. The Clerk to reply directly to P. S. Cripps, Clerk-Treasurer.
