At a special meeting of council held on May 24, 1979 the following business was dealt with:

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by John Bell that the Council of the Township of Ross engage Douglas Patterson Land Surveyor to conduct a land survey on the parcel of land to be purchased from Ont. Hydro. The land located on Lot 37 in the 9th Concession.

Moved by John Bell seconded by Jack Ferguson that Council establish a recreation Committee <sup>composed</sup> of the <sup>past</sup> presidents of the Athletic Organizations and Queen's Lene Stoner's Institute. 1979 committee will be Alden May, Roy Babin, Carol Dowdall, Harry Pelgrin, Michael Kyer, Alvin Stone, Jack Ferguson.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that Council of the Township of Ross grant permission to Ross Township Haly Community Centre and the Forester's Falls Athletic Association to apply for a special Occasion permit to serve alcoholic beverages at their annual street dance for the year 1979.

Also that permission be granted to the Haly Community Centre to block off Haly Main Street from Lots 1 to 6 inclusive on R.P. 84 on July 28 from 9 pm to 1 A.M. 1979.
