The regular monthly meeting of the Ross Municipal Council was held on June 5, 1979 with all members present.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that the minutes be adopted & circulated.

Moved by John Bell seconded by Jack Ferguson that the council of the Township of Ross amend by-law #47-75 section 2. to read "No work be commenced, until the owner pays in advance the sum of One Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$150.00) which is the minimum charge for any entrance way. If the culvert pipe required, as determined by the Road Superintendent, is larger in diameter than 15 inches, or more than 20 feet in length, & is located where more than the usual amount of fill is required, the owner shall remit in advance an amount determined by the Road Superintendent to cover the additional cost to the Corporation for the extra material and work involved."

Moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Alvin Stone that council pay road voucher no. 5 in the amount of \$3,024.95 for the month of May 1979.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that the Council of the Township of Ross enter into an agreement with the Township of Norton for the purpose of providing emergency fire service to Norton Township properties along the Ross and Norton Township line with the Township of Norton to assume the cost of this service at a rate of \$100.00 per house.

A special meeting of council was held on June 26th, 1979 in the Council Chambers to discuss the water system in Forester's Falls.

Representatives from Ministry of Environment & Green Gully & Associates presented their report to council. They advised fixing tops of wells, relining etc or new wells throughout the village.

A public meeting was arranged for July 19th, 20.0 P.M. to discuss with the ratepayers the grant available for corrections.

Moved by Alvin Stoe seconded by Ray Bennett that council pass a resolution accepting the report on Long-term Water Systems for Forester's Falls, Township of Ross as presented by the Engineer and Ministry of Environment. Agreeing to implement the recommendations of the report, subject to receiving grant monies from the Ministry.

Moved by John Bell seconded by Jack Ferguson that the Municipality of the Township pass a resolution requesting the County Road Committee to seriously consider upgrading the main street in Forester's Falls, County Road 7, including rebuilding, resurfacing, drainage and catch basins in 1980 if possible, from the bridge at the east end to the curve hill at the west end.
