A special meeting of council was held on June 26th, 1979 in the
 Council Chamber to discuss the water systems in Forester's Falls.

Representatives from Ministry of Environment & Green Beltway
 & Associates were presented their report to council. They advised
 fixing tops of wells, relining etc or new wells throughout the village.

A public meeting was arranged for July 19th, 7:30 P.M. to discuss
 with the ratepayers the grant available for corrections.

Moved by Alvin Stoe seconded by Ray Bennett that council
 pass a resolution accepting the report on Engineering for water
 Systems For Forester's Falls, Township of Ross as presented
 by the Engineer and Ministry of Environment. Agreeing to implement
 the recommendations of the report, subject to receiving grant
 monies from the Ministry.

Moved by John Bell seconded by Jack Ferguson that the
 Municipality of the Township pass a resolution requesting the
 County Road Committee to seriously consider upgrading
 the main street in Forester's Falls, County Road 7, such as
 rebuilding, resurfacing, drainage and catch basins in 1980
 if possible, from the bridge at the east end to the curve hill
 at the west end.
