

Forester's Falls, Ont.

Nov 5, 1980

The regular meeting of the Ross Municipal Council was held on November 5th, 1980 in the council chambers with all members present.

Moved by Jack Ferguson seconded by Ray Bennett that the minutes be adopted as circulated.

Correspondence included a letter from Ministry of the Environment advising that June 26, 1981 would be the date ending the Hell Program in the village of Forester's Falls.

Council were advised that work had been done on the road between lots 22+23 from concession 4 to concession 5. ^{M. Bilgore} Moved by J. Bell seconded by J. Ferguson that the road be officially closed. ^{Mr. Not + stand on what procedure to take for the road allowance between lots 23+24 con 5.} ^{Keene + Clarke instruct.}

Council agreed to have the culvert on the Government Road improved.

Council also agreed to have the Waste Disposal Site ^{certificate} registered.

Moved by John Bell seconded by Jack Ferguson that council accept the tender of Gally Buchanan for winter sand screened, approximately 1000 tons @ \$2.25/yd delivered or \$1.20 per yd. loaded.

Moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Alvin Stone that council pay road Voucher No. 10 in the amount of \$8,051.66 for the month of October 1980.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that the Council of the Township of Ross pay General Account Voucher 10 to the amount of \$7393.²⁷ for the month of October 1980. ^{Waterworks Acct. \$795} for the month of October 1980.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that the Council of Ross approve a 10% increase in wages be applied to all hourly rated Road employees for the Municipality. With this pay increase to be retroactive to Jan 1st, 1980. The new pay schedule as follows:

Casual Labour	\$4.76	
Labourer	\$5.69	
Tractor Loader Trucks Grader Operator	\$6.95	\$6.00

The Grader operator will receive an additional 10¢ per hr. from April 1st to Oct 31, 1980.

Moved by J. Bell seconded by J. Ferguson that the council of the Township of Ross pass By-Law #29-80 being a by-law to accept a road known as Meadow Lane, in Lot 7, Co. 3 shown on Schedule B and according to agreement signed on January 6, 1978, Paragraph 7,

November 5, 1980

"When the works set out in this agreement or any part thereof have been executed in accordance with this agreement and specifications, and all Township accounts have been paid, the council shall pass a resolution accepting the completed work".

The said road has been constructed and topped with hot mix by means of the Huckabone Subdivision.

Subject to the approval of M.T.C.

Moved by John Bell seconded by J. Ferguson.

That council accept Don Bulmer's application for the drain loan of \$5,700 to drain 25 acres on L/12, Co. 8.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that the Town of Ross adopt and pay the following rates for elections as follows:

Polling Places - \$30.00

Returning Officer - \$160.00

Deputy Returning Officer - 50.00

Polling Clerk - 45.00

Also that all Electoral Officers be paid immediately following the election on Mon. Nov. 10, 1980.

Moved by J. Ferguson seconded by J. Bell that council purchase a wreath from the Cobden Branch of the Legion for the sum of \$15.00, wreath to be laid by Reeve Alder May.

Moved by John Bell seconded by Jack Ferguson that the council petition the Ministry of Housing for a definition of the Township of Ross, as a single independent planning area. Territory to be included in the planning area shall be the entirety of the Township, known as the Ross Planning Area, planning
