January 7, 1981

The regular monthly meeting of the Ross Municipal Council was held on January 7, 1981 in the Council Chamber with all members present.

Moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Jack Ferguson the minutes be adopted as circulated.

Correspondence included a letter from the Ministry of Housing - re "Ross Planning Area", Council endorsed the resolution received from the Township of North Burgess re - non-resident lodgers residing in municipal offices. Council approved Wood's request to carry 5 days 1980 holidays over to 1981.

Moved by John Bell and seconded by Jack Ferguson that Council apply to M.T.C. for the remainder of the Road Subsidy for the year 1980.

Road Employees met with Council to discuss wages for the year 1981.

Moved by John Bell, seconded by Jack Ferguson that Council raise the salary of Road Superintendent, Felix Rathwell by \$1,500.00 per year. Pay his O.H.I.P. and 50-50 on his Dental Plan if desired.

Pay \$30.00 on a pair of coveralls or pair of boots. Pay mileage at 17¢ a kilometre.

It was moved by Alvin Stone and seconded by John Bell that Council of the Township of Ross approve the following rates for the Township Road Employees.

- 10.0% increase on hourly rate effective Jan 1, 1981
 - 100.0% Ontario Hospital Insurance Plan for employees if required
 - 50.0% Dental Insurance Plan for employees if required
 - \$30.00 per employee per year towards the purchase of boots or coveralls
- New hourly rate as follows:

Casual labour	\$5.24
Labourer	\$6.26
Tractor, Loader, Truck, Grader Operator	\$7.65

The grader operator will receive an additional 10¢ per hour from April 1st to October 31, 1981.

Moved by Jack Ferguson, seconded by John Bell that the Council of the Township of Ross pay Clerk-Treasurer, Mrs. H.E. Wood, an increase of 10% on her 1980 salary plus \$90.00 per month on travelling expenses.
