Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that the council of the Township of Ross agree to renew the previous agreement with Avoca House in Espanville.

Edgar Russell for the purpose of draining agricultural land on Lot 14, Co 8, Township of Ross for the sum of \$1,125⁰⁰. This amount represents 75% of the total cost of material & installation.
