A ratepayer requested that a road be improved at Lot 6, Co 11. Council agreed to consider it at budget time.

A request was received to establish a Travel Trailer & Tourist Camp on Part of Lot 1, Co 9. Twp. of Ross. Council are awaiting approval until By-Law # 845 has been implemented.

Moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Alvin Stone that the council of the Township of Ross authorize the payment of Ed Vouchett # 2 1981 in the amount of \$9,126.78.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that the council of the Township of Ross agree to renew the previous agreement with Avoca House in Espanville.

Moved by John Bell seconded by Jack Ferguson that the council of the Township of Ross accept and approve the application for Title Drain Loan for J. Edgar Russell for the purpose of draining agricultural land on Lot 14, Co 8, Township of Ross for the sum of \$1,125<sup>00</sup>. This amount represents 75% of the total cost of material & installation.
