The regular meeting of Ross Municipal Council was held in the council chamber on May 6, 1981 with all members present.

Moved by Jack Ferguson seconded by John Bell that the minutes be adopted as circulated.

Mr. John Hamilton, a representative from M.T.C., explained the proposed improvements to old Highway 17 from New Hwy 17 Haley West to the hamlet of Haley's, after which following resolutions were passed.

Moved by Ray Bennett second by Alvin Stone that be it resolved that the Council of the Township of Ross accept the proposal of old Highway 17 from Haley's West to New Highway 17 as presented by Mr. John Hamilton on behalf of M.T.C. for the upgrading, ditching, resurfacing and fencing where necessary.

Moved by Jack Ferguson seconded by John Bell that be it resolved that the Council of the Township of Ross accept the proposal of Mr. John Hamilton on behalf of M.T.C. in regard to the Township accepting the transfer of Old Highway 17 from Haley West to New Highway 17, when it is brought up to the proposed standard.

Moved by Jack Ferguson seconded by John Bell that Council give a donation of \$75.00 to the North Peffer Agricultural Society also \$100.00 to the Cobden Agricultural Society for the year 1981.

Moved by John Bell seconded by Jack Ferguson that Council pay Mr. Jack a rate of \$25.00 per hour for work done at the Waste Disposal Site with his equipment also snow removal.

Moved by John Bell seconded by Jack Ferguson that Council
