Ratepayers from Guder Lake Area were present requesting that their road be graded. It was agreed to do it at the current hourly rate for grading private laneways.

The owners of the Ottawa River Rafting Tours agree to pay \$1000.00 each towards the calculation for the Township Roads (Gato's Settlement + McDonald Side Road).

Council are requesting 25 free buttons to promote Tourism in Renfrew County from Renfrew County Travel Association.

Moved by Ray Bennett seconded by John Bell that Council pay road voucher #6 in the amount of \$17,559.11 for the month of June 1981.

Moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Alvin Stone that Be It Resolved that the Council of the Township of Ross requests the Ministry of Housing to develop a senior citizen project in the Village of Cobden, in accordance with the need identified in the Municipal Housing Statement, through the Rural Senior Citizen's Rental Program Section 40, of the National Housing Act.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that the Township of Ross are in support of the proposals as a attempt to correct the problems facing farmers, consumers and citizens in Renfrew County as presented by a representative of the Concerned Group of Citizens. That Council endorse the list of proposals as presented and returned to the attached address.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that the Council of the Township of Ross pass a By-Law to regulate the speed on the McDonald Side Rd to 60 Km per hr.
