Moved by Jack Ferguson, seconded by Alvin Stone that the Council of the Township of Ross pass a resolution to give the Trustees of Trustee's Falls Howard Cemetery permission to purchase 0.4 hectares of land to enlarge the present cemetery on Pt. Lot 5, Con 6 RP 49R 549 Pt. 1.

Moved by Jack Ferguson, seconded by John Bell that the Council pay livestock salvators .17¢ a kilometer on calls.

Moved by Alvin Stone, seconded by John Bell that the Council of the Township of Ross accept the application for Tile Drain Loan from Warren Bennett for the sum of \$15,000.00. This sum representing 75% of the Total Drainage cost to drain approximately 60 acres (24 hectares) situated on S 1/2 Lot 2, Con. 6 Twp. of Ross.

Moved by John Bell, seconded by Jack Ferguson that Hubert Gibman be paid a sum of \$3.00 per dog as dog tax collector for the year 1981.

Moved by Jack Bell, seconded by Jack Ferguson that Council give a grant of \$275.00 to Ross Township Recreation Committee for expenses.

Moved by John Bell, seconded by Jack Ferguson that the Council of the Township of Ross authorize the payment of Road Voucher #7 1981 in the amount of \$52,223.75.

Moved by John Bell, seconded by Jack Ferguson that Council for the Township of Ross approve the payment for General Account Voucher #7 1981 as follows:
