Moved by Jack Ferguson seconded by Ray Bennett that the minutes of the January meetings be adopted as amended. Carried.

Moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Alvin Stone that council pay road voucher No. 1 in the amount of \$13,004.16 for the month of January 1982.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that the Council for the Township of Ross approve and pay vouchers for the month of January 1982 as follows:

Total \$8951.58

Moved by Jack Ferguson seconded by John Bell that council appoint Sam Reed as Drainage Superintendent for 1982 at \$12.00 per hour plus mileage at 22¢ per km. That he attend Drainage Superintendents Course to be held in Stratford, Ontario March 29 - April 2, 1982. Registration fee of \$80.00 to be paid by Township plus room and meals.

Moved by John Bell seconded by Jack Ferguson that the Council of the Township of Ross give \$1500.00 to Ross Recreation Committee.

On Dowdall petition, Galloway Associates was present advising council of the plans to improve that portion of County Road #7 at Haley Industries and Chromas.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that be it resolved that the Twp of Ross pass a resolution effective March 1, 1982 that property owners requesting a Township road crossing for an underground tile drain for drainage purposes the following policy would apply:

(Policy)

Jooste's Falls, Ontario

February 1982.

- (A) Drains would only be permitted if a sufficient out let is available prior to the beginning of constructing a crossing.
- (B) Property owners to supply all drainage material.
- (C) For drains crossing a Municipal road at established culverts crossing. The property owner will be responsible for the total cost of installation except that cost of the Municipal culvert.
- (D) For crossings, other than normal culvert crossings the total cost of installation will be the responsibility of the property owner.
- (E) All works will be conducted by the Township road employees under the supervision of the Road Superintendent and Property Owner.

Council discuss the 1982 road budget and agreed to \$89,090.91 for construction and \$157,046.00 for maintenance for a total of \$246,136.91 with a subsidy of \$136,000.00.

Moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Alvin Stone that council pay voucher #2 in the amount of \$12,602.09 for the month of February 1982.

Moved by John Bell seconded by Jack Ferguson that by resolution the Council of the Township of Less will accept the deed for Part 1 of the Reference Plan 49-5690 and in return give Chromesco an entrance way to their adjoining property. Entrance way will be 332 feet south-east of County Road 7, culvert to be 24 feet in length with 2 gates for a width of 24 feet, plus a new fence along this part of the property.
