Moved by Jack Ferguson seconded by John Bell that the Council of the Township of Ross pass By-Law # 13-82 to regulate the appointment, duties and remuneration of the Township Road Employees effective January 1, 1982.

Moved by John Bell seconded by Jack Ferguson that the Council of the Municipality of Ross set the 1982 water rates as follows:

\$11⁰⁰ per month for each occupied lot.

\$3⁰⁰ per month for each unoccupied lot.

Billings to be three times a year with a penalty clause of 1 1/2% per month after due dates.

Rates will be cut off after 30 days.

Moved by John Bell seconded by Jack Ferguson that council give third reading and pass By-Law # 17-82 to prescribe a lawful farm line fence.

Fire-Chief, Roy Dittburner presented council with prices on a mobile radio for the fire truck.

The meeting was adjourned and the next regular council meeting shall be held on May 5th, 1982 at 8 P.M. in the council chamber.

The following motions were passed at special meetings in April 1982.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that Ross Township Council accept the application from Eleanor Talbot for the position of Deputy Clerk-Treasurer and Deputy Tax Collector for the Township of Ross on a part-time-full time basis. Rate of pay shall be \$4.50 per hour. Working days and hours shall be designated by the Clerk-Treasurer. Employment will commence in approximately 2 weeks time with a 60 day trial period at the end of which time her progress will be evaluated by the Township council.

Moved by John Bell seconded by Jack Ferguson that the Council of the Township of Ross increase the borrowing money, if necessary to meet the expenditures of the Township as they become due from \$65,000.00 and not to exceed \$125,000.00
