The regular monthly meeting of the Ross Municipal Council was held in the Council Chamber on May 5, 1982 with all members present.

Moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Jack Ferguson that the April minutes be adopted as circulated.

Peggy Martin, representative for a Cancer Benefit Plan explained the coverage and invited any one interested to take out a policy.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that Council for the Township of Ross authorize the Municipal Reeve and Clerk-Treasurer to sign and seal all necessary documents, re: Deed from Hally Industries.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that Council for the Township of Ross authorize the Municipal Reeve and Clerk-Treasurer to sign a By-Law to amend By-Law number 33-81 of the Corporation of the Township of Ross as amended by rezoning the lands as shown on schedule "A" from Rural Agriculture to Highway Commercial.

Moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Alvin Stone that Council pay road voucher # 4 in the amount of \$11,755.57 for the month of April 1982.

Moved by Ray Bennett seconded by Alvin Stone that Council pay General Account # 4 in the amount of \$7,423.98 for the month of April 1982 and Waterworks Account # 4 in the amount of \$32.00.

Moved by John Bell seconded by Jack Ferguson that Council accept the application for a Tile Drain Line from Helder Gutz for a sum of \$3,520.00. Drainage to take place on 1/2 Lt 8, Cor, 5<sup>th</sup> Ross Township. Area to be drained 10 Hectares.

Moved by Jack Ferguson seconded by John Bell that Council grant Cobden & District Business Association \$20<sup>00</sup> for 1982 membership.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that the Council of the Township of Ross approve the following mill rate for the year 1982:
