Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that Council for the Township of Ross approve payment for Voucher # 7 for the month of July 1982 as follows:

shall be taken upon the day upon which, under the Municipal Election's Act a poll will be held at the next annual election of members of Council November 8, 1982.
