Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Ray Bennett that Council approve and pay the following remuneration for the Deputy Reeve \$40⁰⁰ per meeting plus \$250⁰⁰ within Municipal travel expenses, with an additional fee of \$225⁰⁰ per year. The Reeve remuneration will be as follows: Twice the amount of the highest paid councillor plus \$250⁰⁰ travel expenses.
