The regular monthly meeting of the Ross Municipal Council was held on January 5, 1983 in the council chambers with all members present.

Moved by Jack Ferguson seconded by John Bell that the December meeting minutes be adopted as circulated.

Council decided to use the basement shut-offs at the third townsite to turn off the water into residences upon owners request, until a better method may be implemented.

Moved by Jack Ferguson seconded by John Bell that the council of the Township of Ross approve the following grants for the year 1983:

Moved by Alvin Stae seconded by Stanley Black that the Council of the Township of Ross approve the following membership fees for the year 1983:

- Assoc. of Municipal Clerks & Treas - \$100.00
- Ross Co. Mutual Fire Aid - \$30.00
- Ross Co. Travel Assoc. - \$50.00
- Cobden & District Business Assoc - \$20.00

Moved by Jack Ferguson seconded by John Bell that council give a \$1,500.00 grant to Ross Recreation Committee for 1983.

Moved by Stanley Black seconded by Alvin Stae that council of the Township of Ross advertise for tenders for the position of manager of the Waste Disposal Site, whereas under the contract the site will be managed and maintained. Tenders will close on Wednesday, February 2, 1983 at 12 P.M. with duties to commence March 1, 1983.

Moved by Stanley Black seconded by Alvin Stae that the Deputy Clerk-Treasurer of the Township of Ross be paid at the rate of \$5,000 per hour for the year 1983, also benefits to include 50% of Dental Plan, and that the Deputy Clerk Treas. Eleanor Talbot be classified as full time employee with an anniversary date of Jan 21, 1983 be established.

Ferguson that the Deputy-Clerk shall receive \$40.00 per day night meetings attended in the absence of the Clerk, \$32.00 per day for travelling expenses while on duty.</sup>

That Council members appointed to the Township Recreation Committee will be paid up to three meetings per year to attend the meetings.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Stanley Black that the Council of the Township of Ross approve the sale of 1983 dogs tags at the rate of \$10.00 per dog for dogs over 6 months old as of January 1, 1983.

Tags may be purchased at the following outlets from January 1st to April 30, 1983.

Municipal Office - Forester's Falls.

H. Desormeaux Residence, Haley Station

Waste Disposal Site.

A collector shall collect \$15.00 per dog from April 30 to June 30, 1983, after which time charges may be laid for untaxed dogs. Collector shall be paid \$5.00 per dog and \$6 per kennel.

Robert Desormeaux shall be paid 50¢ per tag for all tags sold to April 30, 1983.

Moved by John Bell seconded by Jack Ferguson that the Council of the Township of Ross engage M. Yack to remove snow from the Municipal driveway, library, and fire hall, and sand the streets in Forester's Falls when & where necessary, at the rate of \$25.00 per hour.

Also that Clifford M. Laughlin keep the entrance way to the Haley Fire Hall clear when & where necessary.

The meeting was adjourned and the next regular meeting shall be held on Feb. 2, 1983 in the council chambers at 8 P.M.
