The regular monthly meeting of the Ross Municipal Council was held on March 2nd, 1983 with all council members present.

Moved by Stanley Black seconded by John Bell that the February meeting minutes be adopted as circulated.

Reeve May welcomed several ratepayers to the meeting to observe a council meeting in session.

Council heard a complaint re. icy roads through Grant's Settlement and advised the ratepayer that it would be looked into.

Council were advised that the Waterworks Supervisor would be unable to cut the grass @ the Townsite and other arrangements would have to be made.

The Road Superintendent was instructed to put up warning signs at the George Alnstead - Kerr Line corner.

Alden May Reeve reported on Council's meeting with the Honourable James Law, Feb 22/83, which seemed very favourable that he would support our request for a supplemental subsidy.

Councillor Alvin Stone asked to be excused while the tenders for caretaker were being discussed as he may have a pecuniary interest. After 6 tenders were opened Council agreed that Alden May, Jack Bell, Stanley Black & the Clerk interview the two lowest tenders and choose one.

Council had no objection to the \$200 licence from Birchwood Restaurant.

Moved by John Bell seconded by Jack Ferguson that Council pay General Account No. 2 for \$7,430.02 plus Waterworks account No. 2 for \$132.00.

Moved by Jack Ferguson seconded by John Bell that Council pay Road Voucher No. 2 in the amount of \$19,919.46

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Stanley Black that the Council for the Twp of Ross approve and forward a grant for the sum of \$100.00 to the Kennew County Plowman's Association for the purpose of offsetting their annual costs for the year 1983.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Stanley Black that Council for the Twp of Ross give consent to the Waste Disposal Management to construct a building for Out-door toilet facilities at the waste disposal site at a cost of \$200.00.

Moved by Stanley Black seconded by Alvin Stone that the clerk for Ross Township be authorized to contact Cobden Council by letter re their useless Township Dungs.

After consultation with the Ministry of Environment Ross Council has decided that it is not feasible at this time to allow Cobden residents to make use of the waste disposal site belonging to Ross Township.

Moved by Stanley Black seconded by Alvin Stone that the Twp of Ross pass a by-law as follows:

That for future applications for land severance as might apply on the Township Road, known as Kew Line, that Ross Township adopt the same policy as presently adopted by the County of Kennew, whereby the Twp of Ross will pay the actual legal costs to a maximum of \$500.00 for the preparation of a deed to the Twp for road widening purposes. Where the applicant has been directed to convey the road widening as a condition of severance, the Twp will pay for the registration of this deed at present usually \$150.00.

All other costs shall be the responsibility of the applicant.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Stanley Black that the Township of Ross request the Ministry of Natural Resources to recognize the existence

of the Lakes or the Ottawa River System so that full + development will be allowed subject to normal land use controls.

Moved by John Bell seconded by Jack Ferguson that the Township of Ross supports the Ottawa River Development Association Inc. in its effort to persuade the various levels of government to open the Ottawa River for navigation of small pleasure craft.

The meeting was adjourned and the next regular meeting shall be held on April 6th, 1983 in the Council Chamber at 8 P.M.

The following motions were passed at special meetings of Council during March 1983.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Stanley Black that Council for the Township of Ross accept the proposed expenditure for Highway Improvements as submitted by the Road Superintendent. The total sum of road expenditure \$277,500.00 for the year 1983.

Moved by Jack Ferguson seconded by John Bell that the Council of Ross send the Road Superintendent Felix Rathwell, to the "C.S. Anderson" Road School from May 1st to May 4th 1983. Registration fee of \$220.00 paid by Township.

Moved by John Bell seconded by Jack Ferguson that the Council of the Township of Ross requests a supplementary allocation of subsidy moneys of \$5,024.00 for addition to the garage from the Ministry of Transportation and Communications.

Moved by John Bell seconded by Jack Ferguson that the Township agree to pay 12 1/2% of the installation cost of a wig-wag plus 50% of future maintenance costs and install advance warning signals.

Moved by Stanley Black seconded by John Bell that the Council of Ross Township hire Peggy Krate as caretaker at the Municipal Building for the ensuing (6) ten months at the contract price of \$135.00 per month. This contract to be reviewed at the end of December 1983.
