Moved by Jack Ferguson seconded by John Bell that Council accept the quote from Frank Cowan Insurance for the 1983 premiums.

Moved by John Bell seconded by Jack Ferguson that \$1,200.00 be included in the 1983 budget if needed to assist in a Tourism Development Study for the Municipalities of Ross, Westmeath and Bechburg.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Stanley Black that the Council of the Township of Ross would not permit the loan of Snow Plance for any reasons, other than for special Occasions events and then only for a period of time not to exceed pick-up and return of same within five (5) days.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Stanley Black that Council of the Township of Ross approve and grant permission for the Clerk-Treasurer to attend the Association of Municipal Clerks & Treasurers of Ontario Annual meeting to be held in Toronto on July 3 to July 6, 1983, and that the Township will pay the registration fee of \$150<sup>00</sup> for the meeting.
