June 1, 1983

The regular monthly meeting of the Ross Municipal Council was held on June 1, 1983 in the Council Chamber with all Council members present.

Moved by John Bell seconded by Jack Ferguson that the May meeting minutes be adopted as read and circulated.

A delegation of David Campbell, Betty Campbell, Bill Davis and Graham Brown were present requesting a zoning change aspect of lot 15, Con. 6, to allow a motorcycle track. Council agreed to get more information before a decision could be made.

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Approval was received from the Kennewick County & District Health Unit that the water samples were Grade 1 at the Townsite.

Stanley Black reported on a meeting attended in Beachburg and advised Council that the Village of Beachburg would look after getting the grants for the Tourism Study.

Alvin Stone reported on a recreation meeting in Kennewick, which Kennewick Town requested financial assistance from the surrounding Townships. No assistance was promised.

Moved by Stanley Black seconded by Alvin Stone that Council of the Township of Ross approve payment of Road Voucher #5 for the month of May 1983, in the amount of \$24,088.69.

Moved by John Bell seconded by Jack Ferguson that Council of the Township of Ross approve payment of General Account Voucher #5 in the amount of \$50,028.02 and Waterworks Account Voucher #5 in the amount of \$551.50 for the month of May 1983. Total \$50,579.52.

Moved by Jack Ferguson seconded by Jack Bell that Council of the Township of Ross approve the following school mill rates for the year 1983.

Moved by John Bell seconded by Jack Ferguson that Council of the Township of Ross engage David Snithers to cut grass at the Municipal office at \$5.00 per cutting. Clerk to notify him when to cut the grass, payment to be once per month.

Moved by John Bell seconded by Jack Ferguson that the Council of the Township of Ross request the Province for an extension to the grant for financial assistance in preparing the zoning by-law due to the zoning problems involved.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Stanley Black that the Council of the Township of Ross give 3 readings and pass By-Law No. 19-83 being a By-Law prohibiting the obstruction, encumbering, injuring or fouling of Municipal roads within the boundaries

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of the Township of Ross.

Moved by John Bell seconded by Jack Feigson that the Council of the Township of Ross give 3 readings and pass By-Law No. 20-83 being a By-Law to govern the location, licensing, operation of automobile wrecking, storage or salvage yards within the boundaries of the Corporation of the Township of Ross.

Moved by Stanley Black seconded by Alvin Stone that the Building By-Law No. 82-8 in the Municipality of the Township of Ross be amended by adding thereto the following clause--

That with respect to Public Buildings as defined by Section 46, Subsection 25 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1980 Chap. 379, Council shall appoint a special inspector, who qualifies under said section as its building inspector (in lieu of the regular building inspector) for each such project.

Moved by Stanley Black seconded by Alvin Stone that Council for the Township of Ross enact a By-Law to amend By-Law # 33-81 of the Corporation of the Township of Ross as amended by rezoning the lands requesting to be severed (Lot 5 - Con 2) from Commercial to Residential as the severance portions will be for residential purposes. Subject to the approval of the Ontario Municipal Board.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Stanley Black that Council for the Township of Ross enact a by-law to amend By-Law # 33-81 of the Corporation of the Township of Ross as amended by rezoning the lands, Lot 6, Con V (48.768m x 41.454 Part 1 R.R. 49 R 5900) from Industrial to Residential to permit severance for residential purposes. Subject to the approval of the Ontario Municipal Board.

The meeting was adjourned and the next regular meeting shall be held on July 6, 1983 in the Council Chambers at 8 P.M.
