Moved by Stanley Black seconded by Alvin Stone that the Council of the Township of Ross pay an additional \$600⁰⁰ to the Municipal Law Enforcement Committee to cover costs for the remainder of 1983.

Moved by Jack Ferguson seconded by John Bell that the Council of Ross Township appoint Morris Barr as Pound Keeper. Livestock to be housed at Cobden Sales Barn.
