A delegation, Jack McLaren, Donald Lavin and Mike Hughes were present objecting to the speed limit signs at Cedar Haven. Council advised that they would have another look at it before any decision would be made.

Also Bert Olmstead approached Council to improve his road with gravel making it passable in the spring. Council agreed to see what could be done.

Councillor Alvin Stone reported that he has received a packet on Ontario's Bicentennial celebrations and would welcome any suggestions from anyone. It was suggested that the Ross Recreation Committee be approached to help and any young people interested.

Alder May, Jack Bell, Stanley Black and the Clerk were appointed to attend a meeting in Pembroke on October 18, 1983 to hear comments directed to the Flood Plain Review Committee.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Stanley Black that Council for the Township of Ross accept the quotation submitted by Buchanan's Sand & Gravel Ltd to supply approx. 2000 cu yds $\frac{3}{8}$ " crushed gravel delivered to the job site as directed by the Township Road Superintendent. The price for the gravel as quoted \$4.50 per cu. yd. Trucks and load size are to be supervised by the Road Superintendent.

Moved by Stanley Black seconded by Alvin Stone that the Council of the Township of Ross accept Road Voucher # 9 in the amount of \$25,922.⁵⁴ for the month of September 1983.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Stanley Black that the Council of the Township of Ross pass By-Law # 47-83 to amend By-Law # 33-81 or Part of Lot 1, Con. 2 from Rural Agriculture (RA) and Extractive Industrial (EI) to Community Facility (CF).

Moved by John Bell seconded by Jack Ferguson that Council of the Township of Ross appoint Sam Leech as Tile Drainage Inspector for the purpose of Tile Drainage Loans from the Township.

Moved by John Bell seconded by Jack Ferguson that the Council of the Township of Ross charge the following rates for copies made with the Minolta Copier.

up to ten (10) copies - 25¢ per copy.

11 to 50 copies - 15¢ per copy.

51 and over copies - 12¢ per copy.

Moved by John Bell seconded by Jack Ferguson that the Council of the Township of Ross accept the General Account Voucher # 9 in the amount of \$13,390.37 and Waterworks Account Voucher # 9 in the amount of \$392.49 for the month of September 1983.
