

Forester's Falls. Ont.

November 2, 1983.

The regular monthly meeting of the Ross Municipal Council was held on November 2, 1983 in the Council Chambers. Those present included Reeve Alder May, Deputy Reeve John Bell, Councillors Alvin Stone, Jack Ferguson and Stanley Black, Road Superintendent Felix Rothwell, Kategaged, Clymas Maves, Gibson Rae, Albert & Raymond Dunbar, George Alnstead and James Tripp.

Moved by Stanley Black seconded by Alvin Stone that the minutes be adopted as circulated.

Correspondence included the following -

- By-Law # 36-83 rezoning D. Andrew property meeting later in the spring.
- meeting re Fire Chiefs - bulk purchasing
- 3 zoning within County.
- 5 land severance approvals.

Mr. Maves offered to sell the house and garage on Lots 18 & 19, Plan 84 to the Township. Council advised they had no plans to purchase same.

Mr. Rae presented Council with a sketch and requested an agreement under the Site Plan Control By-Law.

Mr. Alnstead requested work to be done on the Township road between Cor. 5 & 6 in Lot 27. Council advised that some work was being planned in the near future. Also there was a very bad weed problem in his area this year. Council commented that it was to be all over this year and spraying had been done.

Mr. Tripp requested something be done to improve the corner at Lot ²⁴⁸ 25, Cor 8 and snow plowing done early after a storm. Mr. Tripp offered land behind the house if a new road was to be constructed. The Road Superintendent offered to have a look at it and see what could be done.

Mr. Dunbar inquired of council what re-zoning changes were required so ball tournaments could be held on the ball diamond on Lot 584 Cor 7. He advised that he would make the necessary application.

The Road Superintendent was advised to put the culvert in across the road between Cor. 5 & 6 Lot 7.

Moved by John Bell seconded by Jack Ferguson that the Council of the Township of Ross accept Road Voucher # 10 in the amount of \$122,407.64 for the month of October 1983.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Stanley Black that the

Council of the Township of Ross accept General Account Voucher #10 in the amount of \$116,650.63 and Waterworks Account Voucher #10 in the amount of \$181.12 for the month of October 1983.

Moved by Stanley Black seconded by Alvin Stone that the Council of the Township of Ross transfer 1983 budget monies in the amount of \$22,844.14 from the working reserve to transportation.

Moved by Jack Ferguson seconded by John Bell that the Council of the Township of Ross request the subsidy from the Ministry of Transportation and Communications on the monies spent to date.

Moved by Stanley Black seconded by Alvin Stone that the Council of the Township of Ross support the application for a liquor licence as applied for by Mr. Wilson Lee for the School House Restaurant. The Clerk-Treasurer of Ross to be given a copy of the application.

Moved by John Bell seconded by Jack Ferguson that the Council of the Township of Ross pass a by-law for the purpose of refunding taxes in the amount of \$57.09 as recommended by the Clerk-Treasurer, as provided by Section 496 of the Municipal Act 1980.

Moved by Stanley Black seconded by Alvin Stone that the Council of the Township of Ross pass a by-law for the purpose of writing off taxes in the amount of \$183.36 as recommended by the Clerk-Treasurer, as provided by Section 496 of the Municipal Act, 1980.

The meeting was adjourned and the next regular Council meeting shall be December 7th, 1983 in the Council Chambers.
