The regular monthly meeting of the Ross Municipal Council was held on March 7, 1984 in the Council Chambers with all Council members present.

Reeve May welcomed two George's High School students who were present to observe a Council meeting.

Moved by Jack Ferguson seconded by Jack Bell that the February minutes be adopted as circulated.

A land severance on Lot 20 Cor. 5 was discussed with the owner and he was advised to submit his application to the County.

After a discussion with the Waste Disposal Superintendent moved by John Bell seconded by Jack Ferguson that Council increase the Waste Disposal Superintendent's contract to \$791.66 per month to expire December 31, 1984.

Moved by Stanley Black seconded by Alvin Stoe that Council advise the Engineer to advertise 2 separate contracts for the construction of the M^cLeod Drain.

Moved by John Bell seconded by Jack Ferguson that Council accept Road Voucher # 2 in the amount of \$4,657.18 for the month of February.

Moved by Stanley Black seconded by John Bell that Council agree to purchase from Josef + Gertrud Gans Part 1, 2 + 3 on Draft Reference Plan prepared by Douglas Patterson dated March 7, 1980 being Part of Lot 18, Cor 3. for the sum of \$200.00 of which \$100.00 will be paid with "Offer to Purchase" and \$100.00 on closing. The Reeve + Clerk are authorized to sign all necessary documents. Fair Credit will be paid \$25.00 for a Partial Discharge.

Moved by John Bell seconded by Jack Ferguson that Council request MTC for additional supplementary allocation of subsidy moneys for the year 1983 in the amount of \$1,777.95 for addition to garage

Moved by Jack Ferguson seconded by John Bell that Council designate a reduced load period on Township roads from February 1st to May 31st annually.

Moved by Alvin Stoe seconded by Stanley Black that Council accept the General Voucher No. 2 in the amount of \$7,997.85 + Waterworks Voucher No. 2 in the amount of \$152.26.

Fireman \$1.00 per hour while on duty authorized by Fire Chief or Deputy Fire Chief.

Week-end Duty - \$38⁰⁰ per day week-ends authorized by Fire Chief or Deputy Fire Chief.

Moved by John Bell seconded by Jack Ferguson that the Council of the Township of Ross grant the Renfrew County Ploughman's Association the sum of \$100⁰⁰ for the year 1984.

Moved by John Bell seconded by Jack Ferguson that Council of the Township of Ross approve the 1984 Road
