June 6, 1984.

The regular monthly meeting of the Ross Municipal Council was held on June 6th, 1984 in the Council Chambers.

Reeve ^{Older} presided and present were Deputy-Reeve John Bell, Councillors, Alvin Stoe, Stanley Black and Jack Ferguson.

Moved by Jack Ferguson seconded by John Bell that the minutes of the May meetings be adopted as circulated.

Ratepayers from Olmstead Lake Road were present inquiring when the dust problem was going to be looked after. Council advised that calcium would be applied later in June. Ratepayers were also interested in having the entire road widened and guardrails improved. Council advised that the road budget has been set for 1984 but would consider it another year.

Correspondence included:

- Heritage Revival circulated information on crafts etc to be sold from their building.
- Ministry of the Solicitor General advised that due to Government restraint the County is without a legal adviser.
- Water at the Townsite is Grade 1
- 3 approval of land severance received from County
- Ministry of Natural Resources request ^{outline} property owners to notify ^{form of} any improvements being made.

Moved by Jack Ferguson seconded by John Bell that the Council of the Township of Ross pass a By-Law for the purpose of writing off taxes in the amount of \$14.68 as recommended by the Clerk-Treasurer, as provided by Section 496 of the Municipal Act 1980.

Moved by John Bell seconded by Jack Ferguson that the Council of the Township of Ross approve payment of Road Voucher #5 for the month of May in the amount of \$13,740.20.

Moved by Stanley Black seconded by Alvin Stoe that the Council of the Township of Ross approve payment of General Account Voucher #5 in the amount of \$43,976.66 and Waterworks Account Voucher #5 in the amount of \$192.05 for the month of May, 1984.

Moved by Alvin Stoe seconded by Stanley Black that Council accept tender submitted by Shiloh Contractors supply and application of binder and coarse aggregate at the following prices:

434.13 cu. yds @ \$16.93 Total 7,349.82

Total tender price \$33,823.76

Tasks to be completed between July 2nd and July 31st.

Work to be approved by Township Road Superintendent.

Moved by Alvin Stoe seconded by Stanley Black that Council for the Township of Ross request a "Cost Quote" from two (2) engineering firms to conduct a Hydrology study on the culvert to be installed on the Kerr Line located on Lot 11, Con. 8 & 9 Township of Ross.

After a lengthy discussion it was with regret that Council decided not to loan Township's snow fence for ball tournaments in another municipality.

Township Building Inspector brought a problem that a ratepayer was moving buildings without a permit. The Reeve was appointed to approach the ratepayer and explain the By-Law.

The meeting was adjourned and the next regular meeting shall be held on July 4th, 1984 in the Council chambers at 8pm.
