Moved by Stanley Black seconded by Jack Ferguson that the October minutes be approved as circulated.

Moved by John Bell seconded by Jack Ferguson that Council request Green Galloway to prepare the final assessment and prepare application for grant for the McLeod Municipal Ditch.

Moved by Stanley Black seconded by Alvin Stone that the Council for the Township of Ross hold back 10% of the total amount of the contract price of Mr. Clapesci on the Kerr Line culvert in the amount of \$1,009.60. Above amount to be released to Mr. Clapesci on December 7, 1984 or earlier on the advice of the solicitor.

Moved by Jack Ferguson seconded by John Bell that the Council of the Township of Ross approve payment of Road Vendor No. 10 for the month of October 1984 in the amount of \$44,929.34.

Moved by John Bell seconded by Jack Ferguson that Council approve a transfer of budget monies in the amount of \$14,000.00 to Roads from planning & interest.
