Moved by Bell seconded by Ferguson that the December minutes be adopted as circulated.

Ralph Brown presented a problem on a curve on his road which Council agreed to look into.

Moved by Black seconded by Stone that Council approve payment of Road Voucher No. 12 in the amount of \$30,043.68.

Moved by Bell seconded by Ferguson that Council approve payment of Grant Voucher No. 12 in the amount of \$9,587.06 and Waterworks Voucher No. 12 in the amount of \$486.01.

Moved by Stone seconded by Black that Council fourths Township of Ross amend motion passed December 20, 1984 to read that Bloorley Township not be billed for 50% of drainage memberships.

Council agreed to close the office ^{Wednesday} Feb 6, 1985 to allow the Clerk & Deputy Clerk to attend a Seminar on Bill 102.
