Moved by John Bell seconded by Jack Ferguson that in lieu of 10 ft of land along the south-east of Lot 18, Con. 5 (Gary Scott), the Township of Ross will construct and supply the wire and posts required to build fence that has been washed out along existing watercourse.

Moved by Stanley Black seconded by Alvin Stone that Council of the Township of Ross accept the application for a Tile Drain Loan from Warren Bennett for the purpose of draining 25 hectares of agricultural land located on Lot 7, Con 8 and Lot 2, Con 6. Township of Ross. Total cost of drainage \$18,200.00. Maximum amount of money available in 1985 - \$9,400.00

Moved by John Bell seconded by Jack Ferguson that Council request the County Planner to prepare the necessary documents to allow a temporary use zoning change on Pt. Lt. 2 Con 4. Temporary use is to allow a second living unit which would accommodate senior citizens only as per agreement.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Stanley Black that Council request Edsel Johnson, Building Inspector to attend an Educational Program in Ottawa March 10-14, 1986 and application be made for \$400.00 grant as part of course costs. He shall receive \$40.00 per day plus mileage @ 24¢ per km.

Moved by John Bell seconded by Jack Ferguson that Council authorize payment of \$722.61 to Mr. & Mrs. Stewart + Prince for services rendered or services dated Aug. 27, 1973 - Aug 20, 1975. Also Mr. McTol.

The regular monthly meeting of the Ross Municipal Council was held on October 3rd, 1985 in the Council Chambers.

Reeve Alden May chaired the meeting and present were Deputy-Reeve John Bell and Councillors Jack Ferguson, Stanley Black and Alvin Stone.

Reeve May welcomed a group from Opeongo High School that were present to observe a council meeting in progress. Present were Lana Hooper, Jeff Kohler with, Brian Stewart and John Delaire.

A delegation from Jeffrey-Almstead Lake Road presented their concerns on the increased traffic and road hazards on this road. Council advised that <sup>some</sup> work had been done this year but more has been planned in 1986 when more funds become available.

Moved by John Bell seconded by Jack Ferguson that the Council of the Township of Ross approve payment of Road Voucher #9 in the amount of \$17,506.00 for the month of September 1985.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Stanley Black that Council approve reconstruction up to \$12,000.00 of the Townline between Ross and Westmeath, west of the Muskiet Lake.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Stanley Black that Council accept the September 1985 invoice in the amount of \$550.00 from Murray Buckwald for work done on the Oatton Municipal Drain.

Moved by Jack Ferguson seconded by John Bell that the Council of the Township of Ross approve payment of General Account Voucher #9 in the amount of \$149,238.67 and Waterworks Voucher #9 in the amount of \$1,012.07 for the month of September 1985.
