Moved by Stanley Black seconded by Alvin Stone that Council of the Township of Ross accept the application for a Tile Drain Loan from Warren Bennett for the purpose of draining 25 hectares of agricultural land located on Lot 7, Con 8 and Lot 2, Con 6, Township of Ross. Total cost of drainage \$18,200.00. Maximum amount of money available in 1985 - \$9,400.00

Moved by John Bell seconded by Jack Ferguson that Council request the County Planner to prepare the necessary documents to allow a temporary use zoning change on Pt. Lt. 2 Con 4. Temporary use is to allow a second living unit which would accommodate senior citizens only as per agreement.

Moved by Alvin Stone seconded by Stanley Black that Council request Edsel Johnson, Building Inspector to attend an Educational Program in Ottawa.
