A Special meeting coinciding with the Council Road Tour was held at the Country Kitchen on May 19, 2000, at 12:15 p.m. The purpose of the meeting was to accept a quote for gravel and approve the year 2000 Budget.

Present were Reeve Alvin Stone, Deputy-Reeve Jack Ferguson and Councillors Don Rathwell, Donna Campbell and Teresa Chapeski.

Reeve Stone called the meeting to order and Ferguson declared a pecuniary Conflict of Interest while discussing the gravel quotes.

Moved by Campbell, seconded by Rathwell that Council of the Township of Ross accept a quote from H.H. Aggregates to supply, crush and stockpile 10,000 cu yds 5/8" gravel at \$4.18 per cubic yard and supply, crush and apply 2000 cu yds at \$5.98 per cubic yard, taxes included, at a total cost of \$53,760.


Ferguson re-entered the meeting.

Moved by Chapeski, seconded by Campbell that Council of the Township of Ross give three readings and pass By-Law No 15-2000, being a by-law to approve the budget and set the tax rates for 2000.

Moved by Campbell, seconded by Chapeski that the meeting be adjourned.
