After the above motion, a lengthy
 discussion took place concerning two
 letters which had been read
 from the Dept. of Public Highways
 relative to changing the route of
 the provincial highway through
 the township. Finally, it was
 moved by John Cowie and
 seconded by Inez Anderson,
 that, whereas notice has been
 received by the municipal Council
 of the Corporation of the Township of
 Westmeath of the intention of the
 Provincial Highway Dept. to require
 that part of Road West of the
 Muskrat Lake, mentioned in a
 letter from the legal office of
 the Department of Public Highways
 dated May 17th 1926, as a provincial
 highway, and whereas notice has
 also been received by said Council
 that that part of the provincial

highway now in the said township of Westmeath and described in a letter from the legal office of the Dept. of Public Highways, dated May 19th 1926, shall revert to the said municipality as from May 21st 1926, and whereas this Council is of the opinion that such a change will be a useless expense for the portion of district to be served, in view of the fact that a fair highway in said district is already serving the people and whereas the ratepayers in the district now being served by the Provincial highway, strongly resent the action of the Government in making this change, and whereas the Township Council feels unable to bear the expense necessarily incurred if such highway is to be maintained by the township, therefore, be it resolved by the municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath, that the Minister of Highways be strongly urged to make no change in present route of the provincial highway and that a copy of this resolution be sent to the Premier, Minister of Highways and Mr Alex. Stuart;
