

Town Hall Beachburg Ont.

April 9th 1927

The Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath met in the Town Hall pursuant to adjournment.

Moved by Robert Wright, seconded by John Cowie, that a copy of a resolution passed by the St. Catharines Council setting the rates for the La Posse ferry be accepted by this Council and a similar resolution be forwarded to the Chief Engineer at Ottawa. Carried

Moved by Thos. J. Burgess, seconded by Robert Wright that the by-law to appoint the Road Commissioners be now introduced and read a first time. - Carried

Moved by John Cowie seconded by Thos. J. Burgess that the by-law to pay out certain sums of money be now introduced and read a first time. Carried

Moved by Thos. J. Burgess, seconded by John Cowie that the by-law for the appointment of Road Commissioners and to allow the amount to be expended by each have the blanks filled in as follows:

Thos D Burgess gives notice of a By-law to be introduced at the next session of Council for the appointment of a, West Inspector for the purpose of abolishing various weeds within the Municipality.

Moved by Thos D Burgess, seconded by John Conier, that a system for the collection of garbage, coming to the Beschling dump be inaugurated under Section 406 Chap. 192 of the Municipal Institution Act. and that Albert Lumsden be and is hereby appointed to collect all garbage at twenty five cents per load and to have the keys to the dump and to be fully responsible for its care. Carried.

Moved by Alex Bromley, seconded by John Conier, that the Sanitary Inspector be instructed to clean up the dump before the garbage collector takes charge and that the Reeve and Clerk be authorized to make the necessary alterations. Carried.

Moved by Jno Camie, seconded by Alex Bromley that this Council do now adjourn to meet again on May 28th as a Court of Revision and afterwards for general business. Carried
