

Town Hall Beachburg April 16/32

The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath met in the Town Hall on above date pursuant to adjournment, present Reeve McLean Councillors Wood Thrasher Collins and Burgess, the minutes of last meeting were read found correct and signed by the Reeve. All bills and communications were read and considered,

Thos F. Burgess gives notice of a By Law to pay out certain sums of money, moved by Jno J. Collins seconded by Walter Thrasher that the By Law to pay out certain sums of money be now introduced and read a first time, (carried) moved by Jno J. Collins seconded by E. J. Wood that this Council recommend the following changes in the regulations of the ferry running from LaPasse to Fort Coelouge,

1 st	for one passenger on foot	15¢ each way
2 nd	trip for more than one passenger	10¢ " "
3 rd	automobile with not more than five passengers - passengers free with auto	50¢ " "
4 th	Horse & Cart or conveyance including driver	30¢ " "
5 th	2 Horse & " " " " " "	40¢ " "

we further recommend that the licensee be compelled to keep a schedule of fares and regulations posted up at all times on scow and wharfs and that a more satisfactory way of signalling from both sides be provided, as at present time there is no way of signalling whatever also that after hours the fare shall not exceed double the ordinary fare

we recommend these changes in fares as being in keeping with the times of the present depression, (carried) Jno J. Collins gives notice of a By Law for the construction and improvement -
