A Special meeting of Council was called on above date at the Village of Westmeath regarding the Street lighting of said Village, notices of which had been sent to every person whose name was on petition - notices mailed Aug 4th Those present at above meeting which was called for 10 A.M. were Reeve John W. McLean and Councillors - S.S. Robinson, A.J. Greise and J.E. Robinson also a number of freeholders whose name was on the petition at 10-15 the Reeve called the meeting to order and briefly outlined the whole situation regarding the installation of street lighting in rural Municipalities, after which a motion was put to the meeting for 200. watt lamps - also a motion for 100. watt lamps and the motion asking for 200 watt lamps (Carried) it was then moved by Norman Reid seconded by J.A. Brown that the 200 watt lamps be put in at price stated in estimate from the Hydro Electric Power Commission of Ontario ~~if a grant be given by Council~~, (motion Carried) it was then moved by J.A. Brown seconded by Richard Dumanior that Dr. E.S. Wood, E.O. Gervais & John Wright

be a committee to look after making any changes regarding the placing of lights in the Village of Westmeath if any improvement could be made on the plan already submitted.

~~The~~ The Reeve then explained to the meeting that if any person who had signed the petition desired to withdraw their name from same it could be done now at this meeting, after a lapse of some time & no one came forward or requested to have their name removed from the list the meeting was closed.
