Town Hall Beachburg

August 25th 1937

A Special meeting of Council was held in the Town Hall on above date by authority of the Reeve the chief business of the meeting being to appoint a man to estimate the value of the timber & wood on Road allowance and also a man to place a value on the land this being in connection with the expropriation by Law re Lots 8 & 9 - Con A.C.L.F. ^{all members being present} the minutes of last meeting were read found correct and signed by the Reeve, The Reeve then gave a full explanation of the business on hand, it was then moved by J.E. Robinson seconded by Samuel Young that Mr. W. Hackett of the Ontario Forestry Branch be appointed to value the timber & wood

and that Mr George Mc Mullen be appointed to value the land for the Township, (the motion Carried)
 a discussion then took place regarding Cattle running at large on highways within the Municipality & way & means to prevent same, it was then moved by J. E. Robinson seconded by Albert Germais that Maise Germais be appointed to impound all Cattle found running at large on highways within the Municipality in his jurisdiction as Sanitary Inspector, (motion Carried)
 it was then moved by Samuel Young seconded by J. E. Robinson that the Reeve & Treasurer be authorized to issue checks for payment to Wm Hawkins & George Mc Mullen for their services for valuing timber and land in connection with expropriation by Law, Carried
 Council then adjourned to meet again on Sept 18th
