Feb 12th 1938

The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath met in the Town Hall on above date pursuant to adjournment;  
Those present were Reeve The Lean Councillors - Greise - Young & McMullen,  
The minutes of last meeting were read found correct and signed by the Reeve,  
All bills and Communications were read and Considered,  
Samuel Young gives notice of a Bylaw to rescind By Law No 189 - moved by Samuel Young seconded by Arthur Greise that the Bylaw to rescind By Law No 189 be now introduced and read a first-time (Carried)  
moved by Arthur Greise seconded by James Mc Mullen that this Council recommend the Hydro Electric Power Commission of Ontario to Cancel Contract in the Hamlet of Westmeath in name of Miss Rae Smith (Carried)  
moved by Arthur Greise seconded by Samuel Young that the Bylaw to rescind By Law No 189 - of May 29th 1937 - regarding licensing Slot machine etc & all similar devices be now read a second & third time short and passed (Carried)

 Samuel Young gives notice of a By Law for the improvement and maintenance of Roads within the Municipality for the year 1938 - under the Northern Development Act; moved by Arthur Greise seconded by James Mc Mullen that the By Law for the maintenance of Roads within the Municipality for the year 1938 - under the Northern Development - Act - be now introduced and read a first time - (Carried)

moved by James Mc Mullen seconded by Arthur Greise that the By Law to pay out - Certain sums of money be now introduced and read a first time (Carried)

moved by Samuel Young seconded by Arthur Greise that the By Law for the improvement & maintenance of Roads within the Municipality for the year 1938 - under the Northern Development Act - have the blanks filled in with the the amount of \$7,000.00 and be now read a second time and submitted to the Minister of Northern Development for approval (Carried)

moved by Arthur Greise seconded by Samuel Young that the By Law to pay out - Certain sums of money have the blanks filled in as follows:

 moved by Samuel Young seconded by Arthur Greise that this Council thereby agree to rent the Town Hall to the Beachburg Women's Institute for all their meetings at a rental of \$2.75 per meeting and that should the Institute expend any money on repairs or furnishings and another Council terminate the agreement that they shall be entitled to a refund providing the Council considers the repairs etc are of value to the Hall and that they have not had the Hall long enough to have been recompensed for the work done, (Carried)  
 moved by James Mc Mullen seconded by Samuel Young that the Reeve & Clerk be authorized to make necessary agreement with the Women's Institute regarding renting

Town Hall and to have all necessary changes & repairs made to Hall suitable to both parties. (Carried) moved by Arthur Greise seconded by James Mc Mullen that this Council hereby petition the Department of Highways to show place that certain portion of Road, known as the Egannelle Road - from the Village of Cobden to Kellys Corner as this is a main connecting link for several Townships & one which is used to a great extent for hauling farm produce etc from a large section of Country - (Carried) moved by Arthur Greise seconded by Samuel Young that this Council do now adjourn to meet again on March 12th 1938 Council then adjourned -
